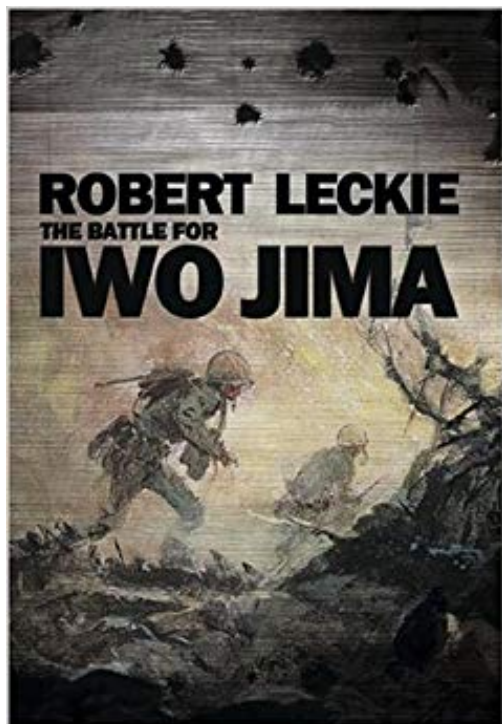

This true American hero was later video taped by The Library of Congress along with many other war heroes to preserve the history of that war for future generations.
